 Following acceptance to Florida State University, all entering students take three diagnostic classes their first year and may elect to go through a “First Year Review” where the top 38 students are formally accepted to the program.

**Participating in First Year Review: 68 (others did not qualify or opted to change majors prior)**  
**Number formally accepted into program: 48**  
**Acceptance Rate: 70%**
